Band Director's Report - Kevin Engel

1. OMEA large group competition this coming Saturday March 6 at Harrison. We will leave the High School at 11:30 and be back around 3:30.
2. OMEA Solo Competition at the Middle School is on April 10. Allison Evans and Julia Swary are working on setting up the volunteers. We may have over 20 students competing from our school. The Music Boosters will provide two piano accompanists for the competition, one for woodwinds and one for brass.

President's Report - Cherrie Macke

1. Marching Band Fee 2010 -Cherrie asked if we should keep it at \$190 or raise it. It was discussed that we have about 25 eighth graders coming in and a big color guard group coming in. There is also a lot of food and supplies that are bought. Sally Grigg motioned that we raise the marching band fee to \$200 and Denise seconded the motion. There will be a \$50 late fee like last year.

2. Web Site Domains - Craig Ramsdell says our current domains expire in September. We pay \$11.00 a year for each one (Madeiramusic.com and Madeiramusic.org). Craig recommends that we renew both for 5 years- \$110. We could renew them for 9 years for \$198. Cherrie recommends 9 years. Sally Grigg made a motion to renew both web site domains for 9 years and Mark seconded the motion.
