Band Director's Report - Kevin Engel

April 9 is OMEA. Kevin went to Mariemont OMEA as some of our students competed; as well as the District 13 OMEA. Looking into some different options on how to handle and charge for lunches for judges. Kevin will know how many schools and people will be involved

Check needed from Darren for 50% of the purchase price as soon as possible. We will be using the white plumes with the sparkles for the band hats. A few of the board members will be picking up the uniforms to save the shipping fee.

Flex credit discussed and information handed out for getting band participation approved for physical education requirement. Applications are due June 6 for the upcoming school year. Kathy Muenz and Kevin are working on the process.
